Friday, December 15: Penance Service at Annunciation, 7 p.m. There will be three priests available for reconciliation.

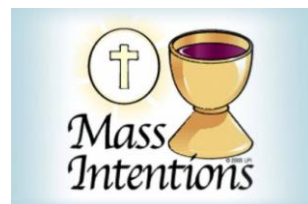
